Notes overview:

- Fares are from transit agency websites – January 2009. Fares are for bus, LRT, and subway but not commuter rail.
- Many regions have comparable fares to the Twin Cities, but have more extensive systems so a transit fare buys more service in those regions.
- Some cities have day passes and monthly passes that cost less than the passes offered in the Twin Cities region.

Individual city information:

- Boston fares are subway, bus fare is \$1.50.
- Pittsburgh charges 50 cents for a transfer.
- Dallas fare does not include transfers.
- San Francisco express fares are BART fares. Peak and off peak are on MUNI.
- Seattle's Metro Transit fares will increase by 25 cents in February 2009.
- Washington DC day pass is for rail.
